Romania is a major European wine country and an important producer of world-class quality wines.


Place of Romania world-wide:

The total area under vine was 197.2 ha in 2009, in recovery as a result of the new plantations.


Area under vine, 2004-2009 ('000 ha)

Area under vine, by main wine regions, 2009 (%)




The evolution of wine production during the 2004-2009 period was the following:

By main regions, the wine production looked in 2009 as follows:


Wine production by main wine regions, 2009 (%)





Romanian wine exports, 2000-2009 (mio US\$)





Romanian wine exports by main countries of destination, 2009 (%)



Wine Imports.


In 2009, Romania's wine imports reached a level of 130.2 thousand hl, in value of 23.0 million US\$, showing a sharp decline in both quantity and value terms, a sign of the diminished local consumption determined by the economic crisis.
